

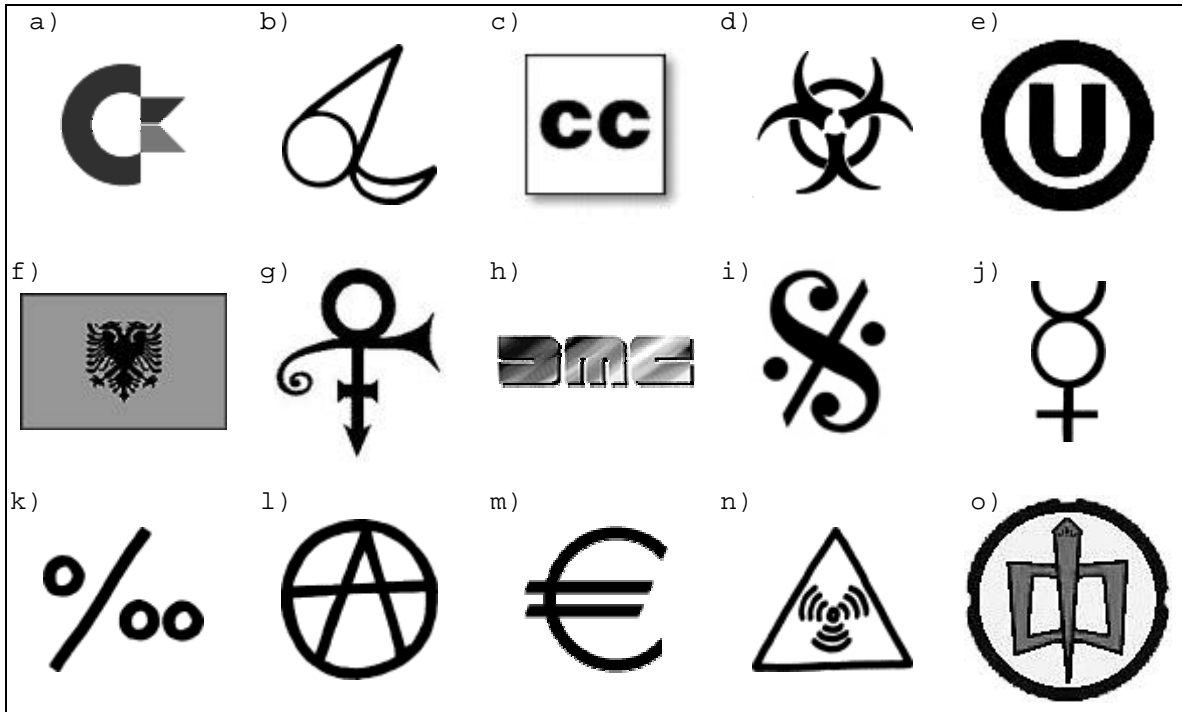

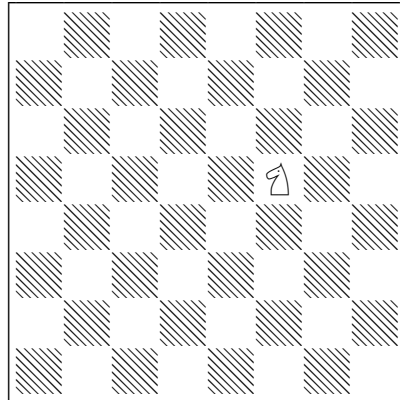

- c. There is the same amount of water in the alcohol as alcohol in the water.
- d. There is not enough information given to solve this problem.
